## Mount Forest Drive Renewal

The City of Burlington will be replacing the asphalt roadway on Mount Forest Drive along with the curb and gutter for the full length of the roadway. In addition, the City of Burlington will be realigning the intersection of Mount Forest Drive and Meadowbrook Road as well as installing a new all way stop at this intersection.

The project will include the following features:

- Full depth asphalt replacement.
- Full curb and gutter replacement.
- Spot sidewalk repairs.
- New transit pads.
- Storm sewer repairs and improvements.
- Short duration local road closure from Meadowbrook Road to Mountainside Drive.

### What is a Public Information Center?

A Public Information Center (PIC) is an opportunity for City of Burlington Staff to present an upcoming project to the community. It is an opportunity for the public to learn about a project, ask questions, share feedback and meet with City Staff about changes in your community. This in-person PIC will have an information handout with information about the Prospect Street project as well as display boards showing the construction impacts on your property.

### Driveway and Property Impacts

This PIC is being held to provide residents and business owners' with specific information about the upcoming construction project on Prospect Street, Dynes Road, Regency Court, Stevenson Drive, Tecumseh Drive and Legion Road. This PIC will be based on impacts to residential and business properties over the duration of the project and the work the City and the Region will be completing in front of each property.
