Upper Middle Road Phase One Minor Reconstruction and Watermain Installation

Guelph Line to Mountain Grove Ave

Public Information Center Notification – June 25, 2026

The City of Burlington will be resurfacing the roadway and installing new bicycle facilities on Upper Middle Road from Guelph Line to Mountain Grove Ave . This is a joint project with the Region of Halton. The Region will be replacing Watermain on Upper Middle Road as part of this project.

The project will include the following features:

- Resurfacing the roadway
- Spot curb and gutter replacement
- Full sidewalk replacement and widening
- Installation of cycle tracks
- Installation of a new concrete median with approximately 60 new trees in the center of the roadway
- Transformation of Upper Middle Road from a five-lane cross section to a four-lane cross section.
- Installation of new watermain
- Street light relocations and improvements
- Traffic signal improvements

Project Schedule and Traffic Impacts

The tentative project schedule is as follows:

Project	Schedule	Traffic Impacts
Watermain Construction	October 2026 to April 2027	Lane Restrictions
South Side Road Restoration	April 2027 to June 2027	Lane restrictions
North Side Road Restoration	June 2027 to September 2027	Local lane closures as required. Local Road closures as required.

What is a Public Information Center?

A Public Information Center (PIC) is an opportunity for City of Burlington Staff to present an upcoming project to the community. It is an opportunity for the public to learn about a project, ask questions, share feedback and meet with City Staff about changes in your community. 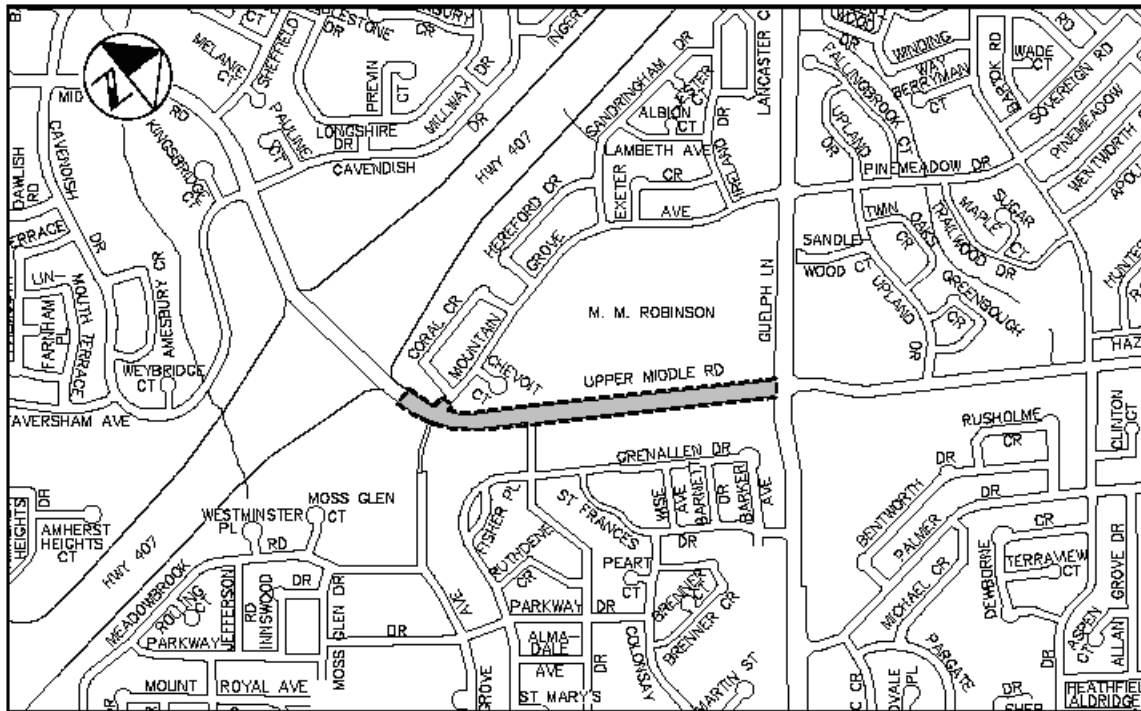
