Rambo Creek at Victoria Avenue Erosion Control Notice of Public Information Centre

BACKGROUND

The Creek Inventory and Assessment completed in 2020/21 identified several areas of channel erosion and bank instability along the Rambo Creek corridor, posing risks to private property, municipal infrastructure, aquatic habitat, and public safety. The assessment identified the section of Rambo Creek between Victoria Avenue and Emerald Crescent as a priority area requiring rehabilitation and erosion mitigation measures.

The focus of this project is to address the identified erosion concerns along Rambo Creek between Victoria Avenue and Emerald Crescent. The proposed restoration works include bank stabilization and protection, regrading and restoration of the channel bed, improvements to existing stormwater outfalls, and restoration of disturbed areas with native vegetation.

As public engagement is an important part of the city projects, the City will be holding the Public Open House where the final design and implementation (construction) timing will be discussed. Public input and comments are welcomed and will be considered in the completion of the project.
