### **Pre-Application Community Meeting for 800 Burloak Dr.**

- Emshih Developments Inc. and MB1 Development Consulting Inc. are hosting a pre-application community meeting to discuss the proposed redevelopment of the site located at 800 Burloak Drive.
- The proposed development consists of two 8-storey multi-residential buildings containing 151 and 124 units each, and approximately 962 sq.m. of grade-related commercial uses. The development will be geared towards the senior community, providing amenities and support to foster independent living, social connection and healthy lifestyle. The application seeks to modify the existing site-specific exception for the Subject Lands to increase building height from 4-storeys up to 8-storeys and allow residential uses at grade. The application will also address minor reductions to parking requirements and site-specific setbacks for the Subject Lands.

Often transcending genres, Bywater Call is known for their dynamic, emotional live shows, featuring powerful vocals and exciting interplay between all band members.

A powerhouse seven-piece Southern soul, roots rock outfit from Toronto, the band is comprised of Meghan Parnell (vocals), Dave Barnes (guitar), Bruce McCarthy (drums), Mike Meusel (bass), newest member, John Kevin (keys), Stephen Dyte (trumpet) and Julian Nalli (tenor sax).

In 2024, Bywater Call was UK Blues Award-nominated for International Blues Artist of the year alongside winners Larkin Poe, after having toured extensively in Europe. Shows have been praised by European media for years, with references to lead singer Meghan Parnell as one of the best female voices in blues and roots today.

They have also received multiple Independent Blues and Canadian Maple Blues Award nominations including Entertainer, Electric Act and Best Female Vocalist for the 2024 Awards Season.

## Black Umfolosi International

Black Umfolosi International is one of the African continent's most revered vocal groups, with more than three decades of international touring behind them. Their shows feature a capella songs in many of the languages of southern Africa, as well as almost non-stop dancing. The music they perform is a fusion of traditional Zulu music and more modern genres. The songs are delivered with passion, integrity and humour.

The group also performs in colourful African attire, usually changing their apparel a couple of times during any given show.

One of the highlights of any BUI performance is their famous gumboot dance, a tradition which originated in the mines of southern Africa. Dancers perform bare-chested wearing hard hats and long gumboots as they execute incredible feats of dance and percussion. The songs and dance are tied together with interesting and informative banter from the group. A BUI show is a deep dive into the incredible culture of Zimbabwe.

## Jeremy Ledbetter Trio

Forged in a cauldron of raging, inspiring contemporary jazz, the Jeremy Ledbetter Trio pushes the boundaries of jazz and world music, providing an undiluted display of rampaging energy and captivating musicianship. Audiences must exercise caution. People who see this band are rarely the same again. If the Jeremy Ledbetter Trio were an inanimate object it would be a runaway train.

Jeremy Ledbetter has been creating genre-bending original music since forming the Caribbean Latin jazz outfit CaneFire in 2004. Since then, he has worked closely with an international array of artists that includes David Rudder, Eliana Cuevas, the Larnell Lewis Band, Aquiles Baez, Alexis Baro, OKAN, Rinse the Algorithm, Patricia Cano, and more.

The Jeremy Ledbetter Trio sees Jeremy joined by Grammy-winning drummer Larnell Lewis of Snarky Puppy and renowned electric bassist Rich Brown, who offer the perfect counterpart to Ledbetter's iconoclastic energy at

the piano. The Trio's debut album *Got a Light?*, released in 2018, has been described as "a controlled explosion of big ideas and compelling musical storytelling".
