LEARN CYCLING SAFETY STRATEGIES AND OUR RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES WHILE ON A BIKE

As long summer days continue, many of us want to enjoy cycling for recreation or as a way to get around. Before you head out on two wheels this summer, get informed! Ian Brisbin, a local lawyer, avid cyclist, and cycling advocate, talks about the best bike safety strategies and the rights and responsibilities of cyclists.
