Join the Friends of Freeman Station for a trip back to a century ago - to the "Garden of Canada" during the Golden Age of Steam at the 1906 Grand Trunk Railway Freeman Station - Burlington's distribution hub for fresh fruits and vegetables. In the 1920s, farmers would bring local crops to the station by horse cart to be loaded onto refrigerated boxcars and shipped to Toronto. Berries picked that morning were served at Toronto's Royal York Hotel for breakfast. Some produce was packed into wooden baskets (hand-made mostly by women workers) at a factory beside the rail station. Other fruits and vegetables were packed and canned as jam and jellies at the canning facility nearby. Watch melons, apples and pears get shipped to destinations across the world - as recreated by our 1/24 scale model train diorama. There will be lots of hands-on interactive activities and admission is free.

Displaying in the Lakeshore Gallery at the AGB from August 16th - January 14th, 2023, is artist Noni Kaur's rangoli art. The exhibit, ਨਜ਼ਰ ਨਾ ਲੱਗੇ / *Nazar na lage / Knock on wood*, highlights the effect of cultural conditioning on labour-intensive rituals of preparations. Rangoli takes months to complete – beginning by hand-dying mounds of desiccated coconut and then forming the design in situ. The shape of Kaur's rangoli begins with an O, a historic symbol of feminine energy. As the work morphs and curves, it begins to take on an abstract human form.

As time passes, the desiccated coconut and non-toxic materials allow the artwork to become a repository of energy for the microbial systems living in the installation. The mylar window works depicts the microbial formations occurring deep in the rangoli. Images of the cellar forms are projected on the sculptural floor installation as the sun's light changes throughout the day.

As the work slowly decays over the course of the exhibition, it mirrors the cycle of life, death, and return to the earth.

The *Future of Work: Parallel Economies* will be running from August 27 - December 31 in the Lee-Chin Gallery at the Art Gallery of Burlington. Admission is always free!
