6. **Approval of Minutes:**

6.1 Approve minutes from the meeting held November 24, 2025

Minutes from the meeting held November 24, 2025, were approved.

8. **Regular Items:**

8.1 Transit

Tony provided the following updates:

- Service improvements have been made, an example of this is bus service on Sundays. Bus times have been extended until 11:00pm. Staff will continue to monitor this to see how it does - they will see if people are taking the bus at this time.
- The 5 Year Strategic Plan work is on-going.
- The Transit Signal Priority project is in the testing phase. Equipment has been installed on buses and is being tested. Progress is being made.

Questions from committee members:

- Concerns about snow clearing and safety with getting off of the bus in areas where the snow has not been cleared. Staff advised that snow clearing work is performed by Roads, Parks and Forestry, but they will pass this concern along to them.
- Will there be ARGO electric buses coming to Burlington? Staff advised that this may be explored in the future. The City is going to look at this technology, but at this point in time it is for education purposes.

8.2 Transportation Planning and Active Transportation

Kaylan provided the following updates:

10.1 Zoning By-law project

- It is currently being reviewed.
- There are multiple phases to this project, the current phase is focused on low density residential (single family homes).
- It is a large project that is broken down into pieces.
- Current phases of the project do not involve transportation, but future phases may implicate transportation and at those stages, there would be opportunities for Advisory Committees to provide input.

10.2 2025 annual report, 2026 work plan and budget
